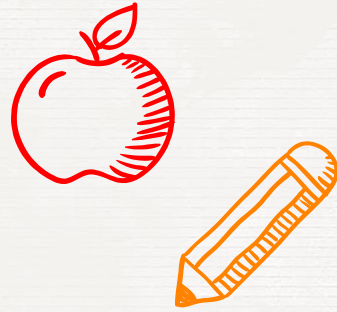

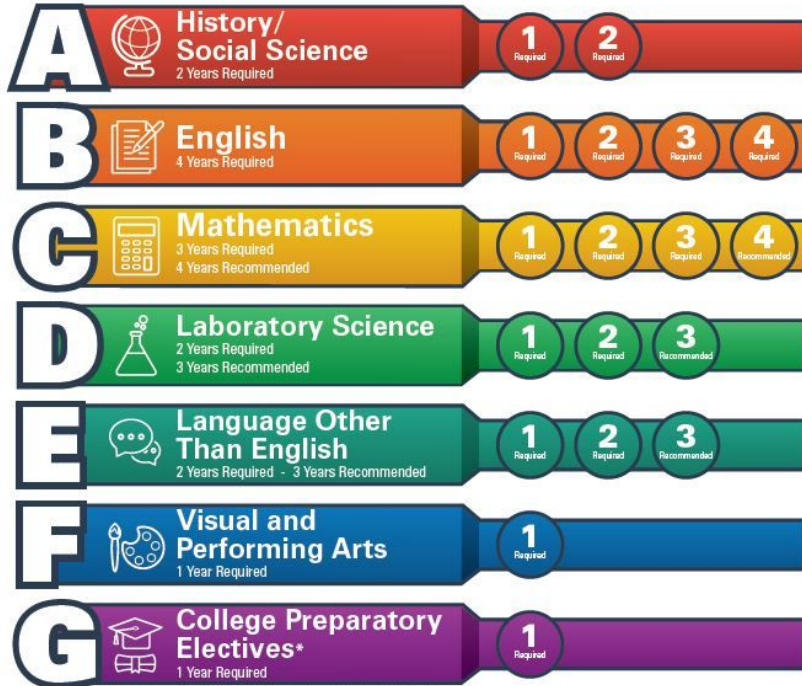

A-G REQUIREMENTS

The University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU) systems require that students complete at least 15 courses in the areas listed below to be considered for admissions. Courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. Additional coursework beyond the minimum requirements is strongly recommended.



A-G Eligibility

(CSU/UC minimum eligibility requirements)

History: 20 credits

10 credits: World History (10th grade)

10 credits: US History (11th grade)

English: 40 credits

Math: 30 credits (40 recommended)

(Math I, Math II, Math III minimum)

Science: 20 credits (30 recommended)

10 credits: Life Science

10 credits: Physical Science

Language: 20 credits (same language)

Visual/Performing Art: 10 credits

College Prep Elective: 10 credits

Remember:

C grades or better in all A-G classes is required to be eligible to apply to a 4 year university!



Testing Requirements (SAT/ACT):

UC system: Not Required

CSU system: Not Required

Private and out-of-state Universities all have their own requirements.

College Overview



Majors & Degrees

Majors are courses of study in college.

Associate's Degree:

"2 year degree" awarded by Community College (*you do not have to have an associates degree, and can continue to go to Bachelors degree without it)

Bachelor's Degree:

"4 year degree" awarded by 4 Year Universities (UCDavis, Sac State, etc). Typically a minimum of 120 units required

Master's Degree:

Additional study in a specialized field after obtaining a Bachelor's degree, typically 2-4 years on top of Bachelor's Degree (*you can skip the Master's if you want or allowed for PhD programs)

Professional Degree / Doctorate:

Specialization in specific areas, typically between 3-10 years. Require Bachelor degrees prior to getting into these programs (including medical school, law school, etc)

CSU / UC / Private & Out-of-State Universities



CSU (California State University): Required to meet A-G courses, and have a minimum of a 2.5 GPA. Apply senior year from Oct. 1- Nov. 30

UC (University of California): Required to meet A-G courses, and have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA. Must include extracurriculars on application and answer Personal Insight Questions. Apply senior year from Oct. 1 - Nov. 30

(application opens in August to work on: can submit 10/1-11/30)

Private/Out-of-State: All requirements, due dates, and applications are different. Should focus on UC eligibility to be competitive. Apply senior year



- 10 campuses in CA – only 9 open for undergraduates
- Focused more on research
- Minimum GPA is 3.0
- Admission is based upon:
 - A–G Courses and GPA
 - Extracurricular Activities and Involvement
 - Personal Insight Questions

- Impacted Majors and Campuses will have stricter requirements

- Applications accepted from October 1st to November 30th of senior year
 - Fee Waiver = 4 FREE APP'S (determined by the UC application)





- 23 campuses
- Focused more on practical hands-on training
- Minimum GPA is 2.5
- Admission based upon:
 - A-G Courses and GPA
- Impacted Majors and Campuses will have stricter requirements
- Applications accepted from October 1st to November 30th of senior year
 - Fee Waiver = 4 FREE APP'S (determined by the CSU application)

- 116 campuses
- Admission is open to anyone pursuing higher education
- Offer career and technical training
- Provide transfer options for those seeking Bachelor Degrees
- Currently, tuition is free for the first 2 years*
 - Must fill out the FAFSA or Dream Act during senior year
 - Must be a fulltime student
 - Must maintain satisfactory academic progress





- More than 80 campuses
- Typically more costly, but provide large scholarships/financial aid packages
- Typically smaller class sizes and faster graduation rates
- Target students that are of good academic standing and in line with the school mission
- Requirements, deadlines, and application processes will vary depending on the University

- Californiacolleges.edu offers a great search tool for California and out-of-state colleges and universities



Community service refers to **service** that a person performs for the benefit of his or her local community. It must be for a non-profit organization, school, church or public agency.

What is Financial Aid?

*Financial Aid is a term used to encompass school loans, grants, work-study, and scholarships to help pay for post high school education

What is the FAFSA?

*The Free Application for Federal Student Aid is an application that is submitted before **EACH** year of college. The application opens October 1st and needs to be completed before March 2nd. The application is submitted to be eligible for Cal Grants, Pell Grants, Federal Loans (*typically lower interest rates than private loans*) and **MUST** be submitted to be eligible for the 2 years of free tuition at California Community Colleges.

What is the CADAA?

*The California Dream Act Application allows students interested in attending eligible California Colleges, Universities, and Career Education Programs to apply for state financial aid. It is submitted before **EACH** year of college. The application opens October 1st and needs to be completed before March 2nd. This application is unrelated to the federal Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program.





FAFSA

- U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- High school graduate/GED holder
- Eligible degree/certificate program
- Valid Social Security number
- Satisfactory academic progress in college/career school
- Eligible for Federal and Cal Grant

CA Dream Act

- Eligible Undocumented Students
- Meet AB540 requirements:
 - High school graduate/GED holder
 - Attend a CA high school for 3 or more years
 - Submit an affidavit to the CA public college/university you are planning to attend
- Satisfactory academic progress in college/career school
- Eligible only for Cal Grant



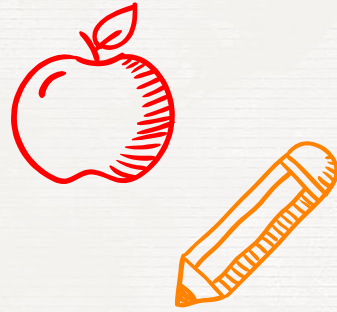

Especialidades y títulos

Las especialidades son cursos de estudio en la universidad.

Associate's Degree:

“Título de 2 años” otorgado por Community College (*no es necesario tener un título de asociado y puede continuar para obtener una licenciatura sin él)

Bachelor's Degree:

“Título de 4 años” otorgado por universidades de 4 años (UC Davis, Sac State, etc.). Normalmente se requiere un mínimo de 120 unidades

Master's Degree:

Estudios adicionales en un campo especializado después de obtener una licenciatura, generalmente de 2 a 4 años además de la licenciatura (*puede omitir la maestría si lo desea o si está permitido para programas de doctorado)

Professional Degree / Doctorate:

Especialización en áreas específicas, normalmente entre 3 y 10 años. Requerir títulos de licenciatura antes de ingresar a estos programas (incluida la facultad de medicina, la facultad de derecho, etc.)

CSU / UC / Universidades privadas y fuera del estado



CSU (Universidad Estatal de California): Requerido para cumplir con los cursos A-G y tener un GPA mínimo de 2.5. Solicite el último año del 1 de octubre al 30 de noviembre

UC (Universidad de California): Requerido para cumplir con los cursos A-G y tener un GPA mínimo de 3.0. Debe incluir actividades extracurriculares en la solicitud y responder preguntas de conocimiento personal. 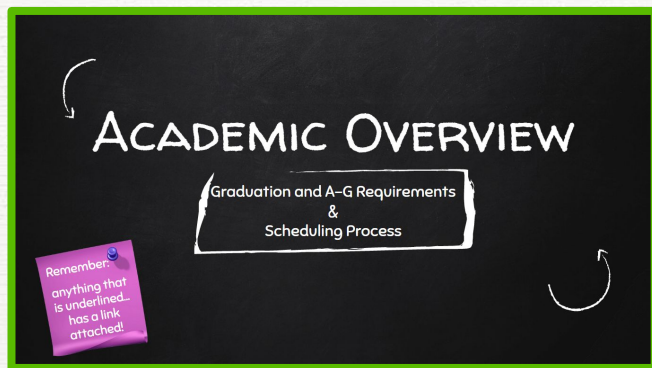


