New Business (45 min.) • Monitor and Review school plan implementation (using spsa monitoring tool) • Data Review: California Dashboard, mid year progress update on metrics	Review SPSA Monitoring tool Review dashboard	Chair/Princi pal	Went over the data over the SPSA monitoring tool to see where the money is being spent. Key points: • Adding dual enrollment courses for students to have guaranteed accumulated college credit by the time they graduate. • Proposed Wednesday evening tutoring to go hand in hand with Saturday School. Mr. Salcido will look into reaching out to students and teachers and replacing some Saturdays with Wednesday evenings. Went over the school dashboard and over the percentages on different matters such as scores, academics and discipline for last school year. Key points: • Attendance percentages increased while discipline has decreased this year. • Students with disabilities and EL students increased their performing scores by 60 pts. while hispanics/white/socioeconomically disadvantaged scored lower than the previous year. • Jen Drewek said the graduation percentage was lower in 22-23 compared to prior years. • SBAC scored low. G.S. commented that not meeting the 97% participation rate had a big impact on scores. K.M. mentioned that students are now aware of the benefits of the test and she suggested letting students know the importance and benefits of the test so that they can perform better. Mr. Salcido suggested giving a presentation about the test and going over the data with the 11th graders. Ramish suggested including it in the counselor

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	presentations. Mr Salcido also suggested giving incentives to Juniors if they score higher than last year's Juniors such as getting a free ASB sticker to enjoy next year's events. A.M. suggested buying snacks for Juniors for in between testing sessions. • Went over suspension rates and what we can do to decrease them. • E.D. asked how the college and career indicators break down. G.S. answered it may be 1. Career pathways and 2. Completion of such pathways. We will revisit this and answer accurately. • Mr. Salcido mentioned the internal data dashboard that is currently ongoing for the current year. It shows students names so was not able to share but mentioned that discipline and suspension has decreased significantly. • A.M. asked about math intervention. Mr Salcido talked about having math intervention time last year. School gave the students the opportunity of attending the math intervention and matching their 2nd semester grade to 1st semester. We started with 30+ kids attending and ended with no students at all. We are still providing math support with in class tutoring and programs such as IXL.
