

WHS Senior Paint Day Agreement/Waiver

Senior Paint Day will be held on Friday, August 11, 2023 in the WHS student parking lot from 7:00AM-11:00AM

As a senior at Woodland High School, I agree that I will abide by the rules and regulations for Senior Paint Day as stated below. ***I understand that, if I do not follow the rules and regulations outlined below, I will be asked to leave and will not be allowed to participate in Senior Paint Day. In addition, my square may be painted over by WJUSD staff.***

1. The student will arrive at Senior Paint Day **no earlier than the designated time** on the day of the event and understand that being on school property before the scheduled time may be cause to revoke the student's participation in Senior Paint Day.
2. The student will not throw paint and/or cause undue mess during Senior Paint Day.
3. The student will only paint the square that they are pre-assigned via a drawing administered by WHS staff. This includes, but is not limited to, electric outlets for electric cars, fencing, blacktop, yellow rumble strip, etc.
4. The student understands that trading squares is permitted as long as both parties agree to the trade and communicate their shared agreement to a supervisor in charge of Senior Paint Day so that they may document the trade on the Participant List.
5. The student will not paint anything on their square related to drugs, drug usage, profanity, sexual content, hate speech, bigotry of any sort (racial, sexual identity, etc.) or any other item that might be offensive or derogatory towards any group. WHS staff reserve the right to determine what, if any, content is inappropriate or offensive.

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5. The student will have with them all **required** and if desired, **suggested** materials to participate and **will take all of their supplies with them when they leave for the day.**

Required materials: (paint, paintbrushes, paper towels, 2 garbage bags to remove all materials, photo ID (school ID, CA Driver's License, CA ID, Passport, a brush or broom to sweep any debris prior to painting, paper plates or other material to rest wet brushes on, water for brushes, etc.)

Suggested materials: tinfoil to wrap soiled brushes, cardboard, or chair to sit on, speakers for appropriate music, painter's tape, snacks/water to drink, scissors, stencils, paint scraper, pop up tent for shade, etc.

6. The student will not attempt to clean any materials on campus.
7. The student will not come back after Senior Paint Day and alter their square or those belonging to others (this includes adding items and/or taking items off).
8. Students will have from 7:00AM to 11:00AM to complete the painting of their square. Designs should be simple enough to be accomplished in this time. It is important to note that scraping paint from last year's seniors is time consuming and should be taken into account when deciding on a design.
9. No more than 5 students may collectively paint a singular design, but each person will only have the equivalent of one square per student. For example, if two students want to paint a design together, they would have to find two squares next to one another. Students who paint a singular design together, will select their square when the first person in there group's lottery number is called. Groups may not use this as an opportunity to position themselves next to their friends while painting their own independent designs. Due to the randomized lottery system, it would be statistically improbable for 2 friends to get squares next to one another.

I understand that a staff member of WHS who finds me to be in violation of any of the outlined agreements, may terminate my Senior Paint Day experience and potentially paint over my square, even if it is shared with others who do not violate the agreements.
