12th Grade Course Selection Sheet Guideline for 2024-2025 School Year

For 12th grade/Senior year, students will have 7 classes: English, Government/Economics, and 5 additional classes (electives or individual requirements for your specific situation).

Attached <u>HERE</u> are the WHS graduation requirements and 4 year college eligibility requirements (A-G classes) for your reference. Questions should be directed to the <u>counseling office</u>.

Students and Parent/Guardians are encouraged to read through the WJUSD course catalog for course and prerequisite information, utilize this <u>visual flow chart</u>, take a look at our <u>CTE Video</u>, and ask questions when needed to make an informed decision regarding choosing classes for next school year.

As a reminder, as we enter the 2023/2024 school year:

- Schedule changes can only be requested up to the 5th day of school
- ★ No changes will be made for period or teacher preferences
- ★ Students may **not** drop year-long courses at the semester

Please note that all courses selected **are requests** and requests are not guaranteed. Course requests are honored based on space availability, meeting graduation requirements, and meeting prerequisites. Counselors will change courses as needed if incorrect course levels are requested

Students will log into their AERIES account and select their course requests by **01/30/2023**

<u>Unscheduled</u>: Students who will have 200 credits and a cumulative GPA of a 2.5 before the first day of school for the 23/24 school year can apply for up to 2 unscheduled periods. The district and board of education approves the applications. Download the attached application, fill out both sides, and give to your counselor ASAP.
