For 9th grade/Freshman year, students will have 7 classes: English, Math, Life Science, PE 9, Freshman Seminar, and 2 elective classes.

Please note that all courses selected **are requests** and requests are not guaranteed. Course requests are honored based on space availability, meeting graduation requirements, and meeting prerequisites. Counselors will change courses as needed if incorrect course levels are requested.
