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Time Frame

Overview of Events

1. Counselors will go into classes to discuss the course request/registration process and remind students of requirements the week of January 22nd
2. Students will enter course requests in their AERIES accounts on their own- **Parents/Guardians are encouraged to work with students to select classes**
3. Counselors individually review every student's course requests to check for correct placement, and meeting their requirements

****Individual meetings can be requested by student and/or parent/guardian to discuss course requests**

Time Frame

(detailed registration dates can be found on the Class Selection page of the WHS website)

- ★ **January 22 - 26:** Counselors distribute/review registration materials in English classes for current WHS students
- ★ **January 22 - February 9:** Current WHS students can input requests on their AERIES accounts according to grade level
- ★ **February 13 & 20:** Counselors visit Lee to distribute/review registration materials and check individual course requests
- ★ **February 15:** Counselors visit Douglass

- ★ Counselors will attempt to contact and work with all students who were absent during their registration days to choose appropriate classes
- ★ Counselors will correct student requests if student enters an incorrect course or does not enter requests on their own

As a reminder, as we enter the 2023/2024 school year:

- A. Schedule changes now only be requested up to the 5th day of school.
- B. No changes will be made for period or teacher preference.
- C. Students may NOT drop year-long courses at the semester.

Please note that all courses selected **DO require** and requests are not guaranteed. Course requests are honored based on space availability, meeting graduation requirements, and meeting prerequisites. Constraints will change courses as needed if lowest course levels are requested.

Students will enter their requests on AERIES
Students will log into their AERIES account and select their course requests by **01/30/2023**

Unscheduled: Students who will have 200 credits and accumulated GPA of 3.0 before the first day of school for the 2023/24 school year can apply for up to 2 unscheduled periods. The student must meet all graduation requirements for applications. Download the attached application, fill out both sides, and give to your counselor ASAP.

Teacher & Student (TA): Students CANNOT request TA as a course option. Students must have a 3.0 GPA in their last semester of classes to be eligible for this privilege. In August student can inquire with student services about being a TA.

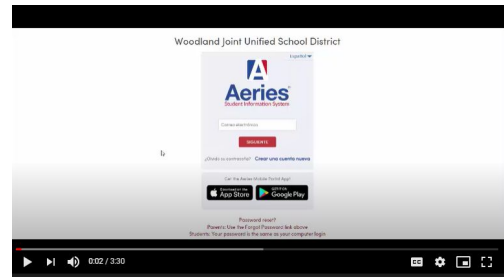
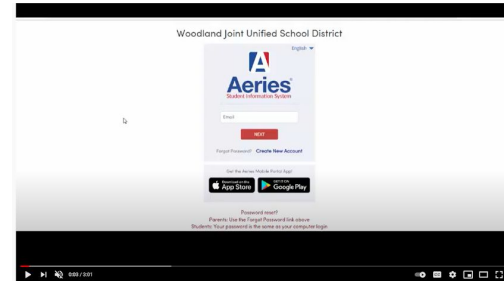
