9th Grade Course Selection Sheet Guideline
for 2022-2023 School Year

For 9th grade/freshman year, students will have 7 classes: English, Math, Life Science, PE 9, Health/Tech, and 2 elective classes.

Students and Parent/Guardians are encouraged to read through the WJUSD [course catalog](#) for course and prerequisite information, utilize this [visual flow chart](#), review the [virtual course catalog for WHS](#), look through the [WHS Showcase](#) and ask questions when needed to make an informed decision regarding choosing classes for next school year.

As a reminder, as we enter the 2022/2023 school year:

- ★ Schedule changes can only be requested up to the 5th day of school
- ★ No changes will be made for period or teacher preferences
- ★ Students may not drop year-long courses at the semester

Please note that all courses selected are requests and requests are not guaranteed. Course requests are honored based on space availability, meeting graduation requirements, and meeting prerequisites. Counselors will change courses as needed if incorrect course levels are requested.

Students will enter their own requests on AERIES

Students will log into their AERIES account and select their course requests by **2/15/22**

(1st: [Change Your School to WHS](#), then enter requests: written directions [English & Spanish](#) and video directions in [English & Spanish](#) also available on our website. *Make sure you are logged into your own student account and are not in "preview mode")

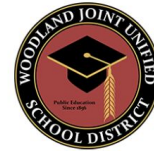

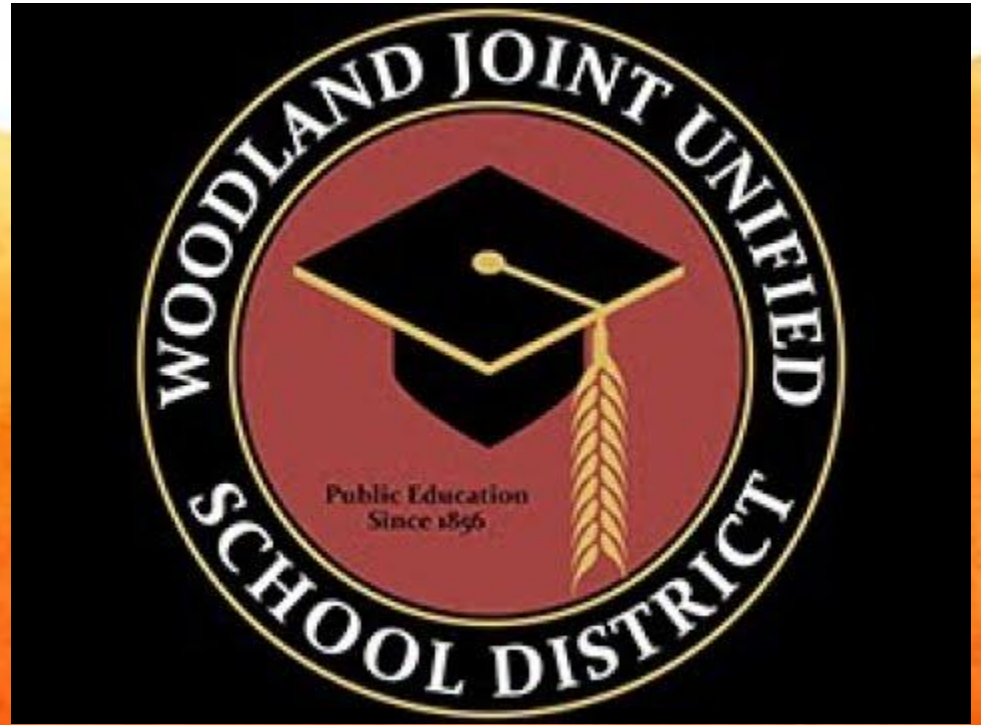
