The Yolo County Farm Bureau Education Corporation Charlie Rominger Memorial Scholarship was created in memory of Charlie Rominger. Charlie was a long-time Director of the Yolo County Farm Bureau and served as the Chair of the Taxes and Land Use Committee Chair. He worked very hard to protect and preserve Yolo County's agricultural lands. This scholarship is designed to give aid to students with a desire to pursue a career in the agricultural industry. This \$1,500 scholarship is awarded based upon academic achievement, career goals, extracurricular activities, determination, leadership skills, and a commitment to study agriculture. Yolo County High School seniors entering a four-year accredited college or university or a Junior College AND pursuing a career in the agricultural industry are eligible to apply for this scholarship. American Legion Auxiliary Scholarship. This scholarship is being offered to a child, grandchild or great grandchild of veteran who served in the armed forces of the United States. The applicant that meets the following criteria will be given first consideration. The applicant must be currently attending high school and will be attending college or a technical school in 2017-2018. An essay of 200 words or more is required. The subject of the essay is what they would like to do in the future and the impact the veteran has had on their lives. The amount of the scholarship is \$1,000. The recipient will be given one half of the scholarship at the beginning of the fall semester when the Auxiliary receives confirmation of fall classes. The other half will

Yolo County Pheasants Forever Mark Breckner Memorial Scholarship: This scholarship is open to all graduating seniors planning on attending an institution of higher education and majoring in wildlife biology, agriculture, or a related field. Scholarship will be awarded based on scholastic achievement, extra-curricular activities, community service, and completion of an essay of an assigned topic. Young Farmer & Ranchers Scholarships:

The Yolo County Farm Bureau's Young Farmers and Ranchers ([YF&R](#)) Scholarships are designed to give financial aid to students residing or attending a high school in Yolo County with a desire to start a career in the agriculture industry or an agriculture-related field. Scholarships ranging in amounts from \$500 to \$1,000 will be awarded to graduating seniors from a Yolo County High School. This scholarship is based on scholastic achievement, leadership skills, and agriculture involvement. **Please be sure that all applicants submit their applications on or before May 4, 2017 with all of the necessary paper work.** Any graduating high school senior residing or attending a high school in Yolo County and entering a two year community college or four year college or university and is majoring in an agriculture based or related field is eligible. The student must be enrolled as a full-time student or enrolled in at least twelve (12) academic units per semester or quarter during the year of the scholarship award.
